The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has given interim approval, for use in Colorado, to encapsulants approved by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Public Health and/or the New York State Department of Health, subject to the limitations on usage specified on those lists.

The following encapsulants manufactured by Fiberlock Technologies, Inc. have been given interim approval by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division for use in lead-based paint abatement projects subject to Colorado Regulation No. 19, Section V.G.4.
